

Abandoned Cemetery, Normanby Twp, Ontario

This ½ acre of land located at Lot 15, Con 4, was used as a burial ground prior to the turn of the century. The following headstones are the only proof that a cemetery was once located here.

Mary McBride, wife of William McBride died June 16, 1865, age 50 yrs.

John O'Gram died 1879, a native of England.

John Colquhaun age 9 yrs. John was a brother of Louis Colquhaun who assisted in a train robbery near Ducks, B.C. in 1906, for which he received a 25 yr. sentence.

The land is now owned by John Bosomworth, who has cemented these remaining headstones into a pad in an effort to remind us that a cemetery was located here prior to 1900.
